By signing this form, you (the author(s) or other copyright owner) agree to grant to us (English Folk Dance and Song Society, the publisher) the exclusive right (subject to the exceptions listed in section 5 of this licence) for the duration of the respective copyrights involved both to reproduce and/or distribute your article (including the abstract) ourselves throughout the world in printed, electronic or any other medium, and in turn to authorise others (including Reproduction Rights Organisations such as the Copyright Licensing Agency and the Copyright Clearance Center) to do the same.
